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About the Scholarship

Dr Betty Rosina Elliott (dec. 20 March 2014) (Donor) was a former student of the University.

The Donor's will left a number of bequests to the university, including a gift of \$250,000 for the purpose of establishing in perpetuity one or more scholarships for post graduate students who have demonstrated academic ability, are in financial need, and will be undertaking research into sustainability in horticulture at the University of Melbourne.

The Dr Betty Elliott Horticulture Scholarship will be awarded to a **postgraduate student** (coursework or research) of **academic excellence** who is in **financial need**, and will be undertaking **research in the field of sustainability in Horticulture**.

Eligibility

To be eligible for this scholarship, you must:

- Be a postgraduate student in the field of sustainability in horticulture,

Selection criteria

Eligible candidates will be ranked based on:

- Academic merit,
- Proposed Research project,
- Level of disadvantage based on financial need.
