### About the Scholarship

*The G.I. Feutrill Awards were established through the generosity of Smith Kline & French Laboratories in Swedeland, Pennsylvania, to commemorate Dr Geoffrey Ian Feutrill. Dr Feutrill was a senior lecturer in the University of Melbourne's former Department of Organic Chemistry who was on study leave and working with the company at the time of his death in 1987.*

### Eligibility

To be eligible for this scholarship, you need to be:

- a full-time PhD candidate in the School of Chemistry
- undertaking travel to a conference in Organic Chemistry outside Victoria
- researching Organic Chemistry

### Selection Criteria

Eligible candidates will be ranked based on:

- Academic merit,
- The relevance of the conference to the student's research,
- The international standing of the conference.

One or more PhD students may receive this award each year.

#### **Application Process:**

Students will submit an application by the advertised deadline to the School of Chemistry Research Committee. The application should outline:

- Details of travel outside Victoria
- Details of relevance of the conference to the student's research
- Benefit of travel
- Details of travel (date, location and budget)

**All scholarship outcomes will be sent via SmartyGrants.**
