Selection Criteria

- Academic excellence as determined by the highest undergraduate course Weighted Average Mark(University of Melbourne equivalent); and,
- Personal statement demonstrating potential to
 - benefit from the scholarship;
 - make a major commercial contribution to the nursery industry.

WAMs will be weighted by quality of personal statement to arrive at a final ranked list for selection.
