About the Scholarship

The scholarship was established in 1937 by Mrs Mabel Ashton Walker in memory of her husband, Fred Walker, a Melbourne based manufacturer and the proprietor of Fred Walker and Co., now known as Kraft Foods Limited. In establishing this award, Mrs Walker hoped to improve outcomes for future generations of aspiring students.

Eligibility

To be eligible for this scholarship, you need to:

- Complete a Bachelor of Science in the School of Chemistry at the University of Melbourne, **and**
- Be enrolled in a School of Chemistry fourth year Bachelor of Science Honours, the first year of a Master of Science (Chemistry) or a Postgraduate Diploma in Science (Chemistry)

Selection Criteria

Eligible candidates will be ranked on:

- Academic achievement

This scholarship must not be held concurrently with the James Cuming Memorial Scholarship.
