The scholarship is valued at \$4,000 and can be held concurrently with another scholarship to undertake study related travel or fieldwork.

Eligibility

To be eligible for this scholarship, you need to:

- be an enrolled graduate researcher (PhD or MPhil);
- be confirmed in your candidature; and,
- be undertaking, or plan to undertake fieldwork in Asia.

Please also note, you must:

- undertake travel before your maximum course duration date;
- undertake travel before submitting your thesis; and,
- submit scholarship application before submitting your thesis.
